1st Day (Monday, 4th July 2022)

The Study Visit commenced at 09:45 at The Mediterranean University of Reggio Calabria which was organized by prof. Paolo Porto. After welcome note and opening remarks, prof. Paolo Porto showed us Examples of torrent control in Calabria: A case study of the torrential catchment Valanidi. He introduced us with prof. Kazimierz Banasik from the University of Warsaw who showed us Examples of Erosion studies in other European countries – A case study in Poland. After the presentations, It was organized the visit of laboratories and information center at The Mediterranean University of Reggio Calabria. Later on, participant went by bus to visit the torrential catchment Valanidi.

2nd Day (Tuesday, 5th July 2022)

The Study Visit began at 08:00 o'clock when participants gathered to take a bus for the Excursion. At first, the Visit of the torrential catchment Menta, the reservoir and the check-dams in Aspromonte



was organized. There we have been welcomed by representatives from enterprises who showed us presentation about reservoir and anti erosion works in basin. Later they took us to field to show protection measures in basin of reservoir. After the visit of the torrential catchment Menta we visited the torrential catchment Ferraina.

3rd Day (Wednesday 6th July 2022)

Third day The Study Visit also began at 08:00 o'clock and finished at 5:30pm. Participant went by bus to visit the experimental catchments in Crotona.

The conclusion is that **Study Visit and analysis best practices in EU countries** from 4th to 6th of July, 2022 in **Reggio Calabria, Italy** was successfully realized. All material will be sent to the project participants.
