First presentation was given by Project Coordinator Nada Dragović which was the Short report of the of the planned and realized activities. Main ponts from report related to study visits (Study visit at the University in Bulgaria—mid-April, 2020 - 13-14 April 2020; Study visit at the University in Italy — end June or beginning of July 2020 (29 June to 1st July or 6-8 July 2020; Study visit at the BOKU in Austria —September 2020 (28-30 September 2020 or 5-7 October 2020) were not realized due to COVID-19 pandemic.


Report of created promotion material - UNI in cooperation with UB was still not realised.

Report of organized 2nd Quality Assurance Committee meeting was given by Paolo Porto. All realized activities are reported. Paolo Porto informed that external evaluator needs to be nominated. Considring that prof Ivan Ts. Marinov Forest Research Institute at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences retired, Eli Pavlova-Traykova was elected by votes of most partners.

Interim report was presented by Aleksandar Baumgertel. Most questions and discussion were related to shifts in the SETOF project budget and deadlines considering COVID-19 situation.

Exploitation and dissemination issues of SETOF project were presented by Slobodan Milutinović. Main issues that were presented and discussed were in relation to organization and realization of trainings for practitioners, local community authorities and engineers. Three potential solutions were given: a) To proceed with activities originally planned; b) To proceed with planned activities, shifting to the on-line by using zoom or other platform; c) To re-plan the dissemination, by changing dissemination channel. It is proposed to organized questionnaire (made by UNI) which will be circulated among partners to decide about modality of dissemination and exploitation of project.
