Summary

This document reports the first kick-off meeting of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education project "Soil Erosion and TOrrential Flood Prevention: *Curriculum Development at the Universities of Western Balkan Countries*" (SETOF) held at the coordinating University of Belgrade, on the 13th and 14th of December 2018. 1. First day
