In the next section, Prof. Johannes Huebl and Prof. Paolo Porto presented the Prevention measures for soil and torrent control applied in Austria in Italy (Activity 1.3).

The partners from the EU countries presented the bachelor and master curricula in field of soil and torrent control (Activity 1.4) in their countries (Italy, Austria and Bulgaria).

Summary what we have done regarding the activities in WP1 was provided by Prof. Ratko Ristić and Assist. Prof. Ivan Minčev.

At the end of the meeting, discussion was held.
