The Headquarters of the University of Niš - one of the most representative buildings (built in 1887, part of the national heritage, protected by the state.


• Founded on June 15th, 1965

- UNI has significant experience in international programs such as Tempus, Erasmus, FP6 and FP7
- Within the EM ECW program, the University of Niš entered the exchange of students and teaching staff in 2008 as a partner in the Project BASILEUS
- In 2011, UNI became a consortium member of the Project EM2STEM
- University of Niš also became partner of other Erasmus Mundus programmes, such as SIGMA, ERAWEB, EUROWEB
