- For Erasmus+ exploitation is maximising the potential of the funded activities, so that the results are used beyond the lifetime of the project
- How the results can make a difference to the project, end-users, peers, policy makers, do they give new carier oportunities?







Exploitation mechanisms include:

- positive reputational effects for the participating institutions;
- increased awareness on a soil erosion and torrential flood control among policy makers (local and national level) et.
- increased financial support by other supporters or donors;
- increased influencing on practice.







GOAL: Improvement of existing curricula and develop and implement new master curricula in the field of prevention from torrential floods, in compliance with the Bologna Declaration and EU good practices

6.1 Sustainability plan created

- Time-line: from April until September 2019
- UNSA will organize the preparation of the Sustainability Plan in cooperation with the other Serbian and Bosnian-Herzegovinian universities.
- **PMC** will adopt the sustainablity plan and subsequently the SC.







6.1 Sustainability plan created

- Sustainability Plan will determine the promotion strategy (website, social networks Facebook, Linkidin, Instagram, by TV and radio advertising, as well as the distribution of printed material to target groups).
- TG: Teaching staff, Students and Trainees
- Dissemination level: Faculty, local, national, institutional and regional







6.2 Accreditation of master curricula

- Task: Accomplishment of accreditation of the master program start after its adoption by university bodies and should be completed by September 2020.
- Time-line: from July until december of 2020
- TG: Teaching staff and administrative staff
- Disseminaton: Faculty, national, institution





• The promotion of master and improved bachelor programs as a part of WP6, will be done based on the adopted dissemination plan.







6.3. Promotion for student enrollment

- The promotion of the new master program will be carried out prior to enrollment in the school year 2020/2021 and continuously during the master course.
- Time-line: from October until December 2020 and from July until December 2021
- TG: Teaching staff, students, trainees
- Disseminaton level: Faculty, local, national, institution, region







- Simultaneously with the education of employed engineers, the validation of the adopted curriculum will be carried out in practice.
- Local authorities deal mainly with the consequences of torrential floods through the rehabilitation of damaged facilities and the compensation of occurred material damage. However, it is necessary to educate local governments, so that they can adopt programs for the implementation of these works.
