




FACULTY OF FORESTRY

History

• Institute of Forestry was established in 1944




• Faculty of Forestry as a part of Agricultural-Forestry Faculty was established in 1947.

• The Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje was founded in 1949 with the following faculties: Agricultural – Forestry; Natural Sciences and mathematic; Philosophy, Faculty of medicine









- In 1975, with a decision of the National Assembly, the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry was transformed and reorganized into two independent institutions: the Faculty of Agriculture (Food and agriculture faculty, today) and the Faculty of Forestry.
- In 1976, the Faculty of Forestry merged with the Forestry Institute in Skopje, and became it's legal successor.
- In 2011, Department of wood industry separated from the Forestry faculty and the <u>Faculty of Design</u> and <u>Technology of Furniture and Interior</u> was established.
- In the following period the Faculty passes through more organizational reforms and developmental stages (1954, 1964, 1975, 1977, 1990, 1998, 2004 and 2011, 2013).

Study Programs

- Forestry study program existed from the beginning and encompasses all topics related to forestry (and wood technology in the beginning).
- Following world trends related to forest education in the year 1999 started 2 study programs:
- Forestry
- Landscaping and Environment promotion
- In 2004, all undergraduate academic programs introduced ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).
- In 2006, the ECTS was introduced in the postgraduate academic programs.





Current study programs - from 2018

- II cycle: Master degree (MSc) 60 ECTS
- III cycle: Doctoral degree (PhD) 180 ECTS

Study programmes focus on:

- Forestry seed/nursery production, plantation, silviculture, protection, harvesting, transport, inventory, forest management planning, game management, forest policy and economy
- <u>Landscape design</u> decorative plant production and protection, garden/park designing, garden/park establishment; urban greenery maintenance
- Eco-engineering and eco-management land and water environmental engineering and protection, natural resources management, protected area management, landscape and spatial planning, environmental analyses, environmental policy and economy.

Students

- Low interest for Forestry Faculty
- After graduation many migrate abroad
- A lot of student prefer private universities and other faculties (trend between young people)
- High quotes for faculties of humanitarian sciences and Faculty of infommatics and computer sciences (trend)
- Decrease in quality of enrolled students





Connection with employment

- Mostly public sector
- Status: Involvement of politics in employment of inappropriate staff (agronomist, wood technology engineers, economist..) even on the most professional positions.
- Part of graduate students can not find employment in the sector and go foreign or work in other sector in very low positions (for primary or secondary school)








Textbooks/manuals

• Only 10 textbooks after 2000. Prepared material (internal scripts) for almost all disciplines but due to lack of finances not printed.
























Staff

• Current teaching and research staff: 19

16 full professors, 1 associate professor and 2 assistant professors, 1 laboratory assistant

no teaching assistants

- Administrations staff: 5
- Other staff: 3
- Teaching and research staff in 1987 (23 professors and 6 assistants = 29 plus 8 laboratory associate)
- Huge decrease of scientific-educational staff.
