Prof. Dr. Slobodan Milutinović, SETOF project coordinator for the University of Niš, presented the project and past and current project activities as a part of project dissemination activities. He emphasizes the fact that all the above-mentioned projects are of great importance for the Faculty of Occupational Safety in Niš, especially for the on-going accreditation process. After the brief presentation, projects' related activities and possible obstacles were discussed. 
