The dean of the Faculty of Forestry – the University of Belgrade, prof. Ratko Ristić started the meeting with welcome and opening remarks.

Assistant Professor Boško Blagojević from the University of Novi Sad reported about the goals, competencies and learning outcomes of improved bachelor and master curricula (WP2, Activity 2.2.). Also, Boško Blagojević gave a detailed presentation about the established new and improved subjects on existing bachelor and master programmes at the Universities of Serbia and the process of approval (WP2, Activity 2.3).





Prof. Marijana Kapović informed participants about the established new and improved subjects on existing bachelor and master programmes at the Universities of B&H and the process of approval (WP2, Activity 2.3).

Prof. Nada Dragović reported about the structure of the curriculum of the new master programme that is going to be established by the universities in Bosnia and Serbia (WP2, Activity 2.4).

The members of the SETOF project discussed the structure of curriculum and subject syllabuses of a new master programme started in September 2020. They agreed about the list of subjects and credits. They agreed about the four obligatory and two elective subjects planned for the first semester and obligations related to the second semester (study research work, professional practice, and masterwork) as well as who will teach the students. After this meeting, the additional proposal for one elective subject came from the colleagues from the UBL. The meeting was closed after the discussion section.
